Week Six Discussion Questions

- 1) Discuss the “First Look” Jesus gives to Peter. How does Christ look at us in our moments of failure versus our moments of potential?

- 2) How does Sheen distinguish between a “social reformer” and a “Redeemer”?

- 3) According to Sheen, why wouldn’t Christ condemn the woman caught in adultery? Discuss sin in the light of the justice and mercy of God.

- 4) How is Christ at once the Door, the Shepherd, and the Sheep?

- 5) How does the Shepherd “lay down his life” daily for the sheep?
- 6) The Chapter “The Son of Man” discusses the *divine dilemma*...how can Christ be “fully God and fully man” simultaneously? What do the titles “The Son of Man” and “The Son of God” tell us about this dilemma and what clues to they give us to understanding it?
- 7) What point is Sheen trying to drive home in his discussions about Christ’s “Hour”. Why is that important for us as followers of Christ to understand? What does it mean to you in your personal relationship with Christ?
